CUW is located 20 miles north of Mitchell International Airport, Milwaukee, WI.

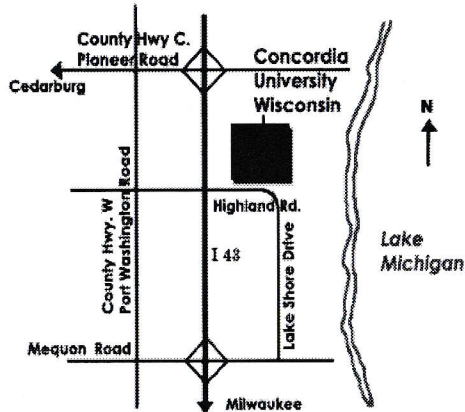
DIRECTIONS—Traveling on Interstate Hwy 43:

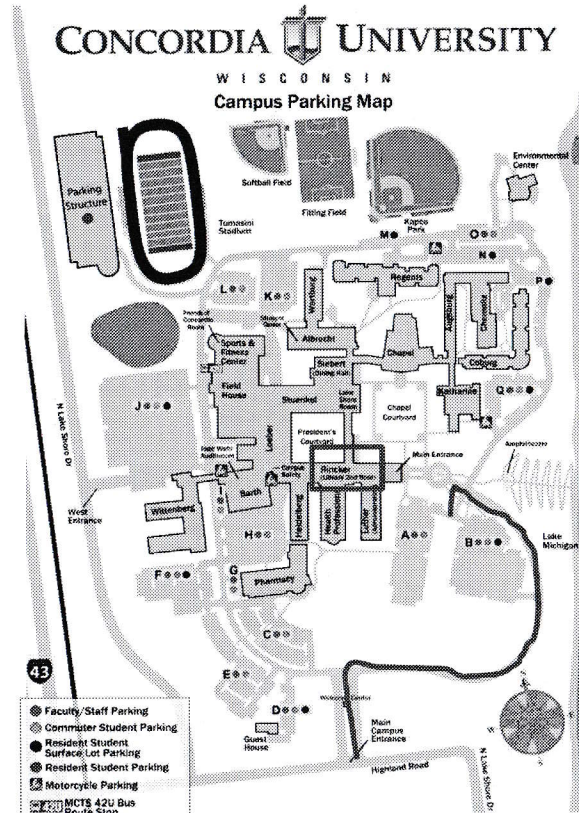
