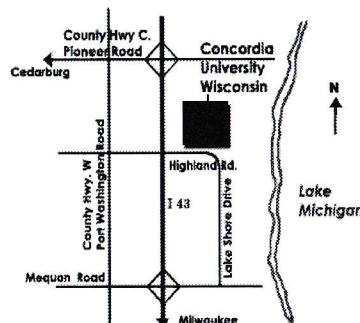
DIRECTIONS—Traveling on Interstate Hwy 43:

FROM THE NORTH:

Take the Cedarburg exit (Pioneer Rd/ Highway C). Turn right to Highway W (Port Washington Rd.). Turn left on W to Highland Rd. (2 miles). Turn left on Highland, go across the bridge to CUW on the left.



Once you enter the campus, turn right at the Welcome Center stop sign, and follow the roadway to Lot A by the flagpole. Enter Luther Administration building and follow conference signs to Albrecht Terrace Room.
